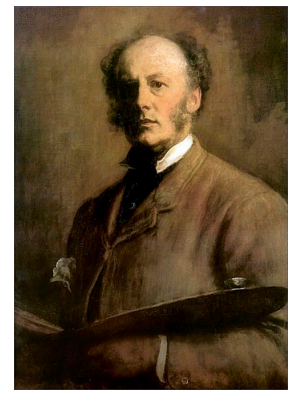

British, Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood

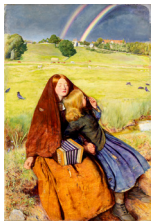


Self-portrait, 1881

The Blind Girl

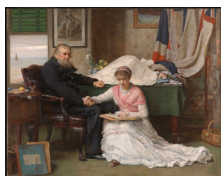

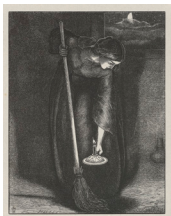
The North-West Passage
